

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Kane County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No R-2020-31 giving notice of intent to include Road Dust Mitigation as a service of the Cedar Mountain Fire Protection District

The Service may cover all roads within the District or may be limited to certain roads as determined by the Board of the District.

Currently, there are no property taxes levied annually related to this district and there is no intent to do so in the near future. There are currently fees assessed to properties in the District and this new service will likely result in additional fees. Under state law, taxes may be levied annually upon all taxable property within the District and fees or charges may be imposed to pay for some or all of the services that the District provides.

A Public Hearing will be held January 5, 2021, at 6:00 P.M. MST at the Kanab Center, 20 N 100 E in the Kane School District Board room. The public are welcome to give written or oral comments.

Under Utah Code 17D-1-206 an interested person may protest the proposed additional service. Each protest shall be in writing, explaining why the person is protesting, submitted no later than 12:00 noon March 8, 2021, to the Kane County Commission 76 N Main, Kanab, Utah 84741.
